

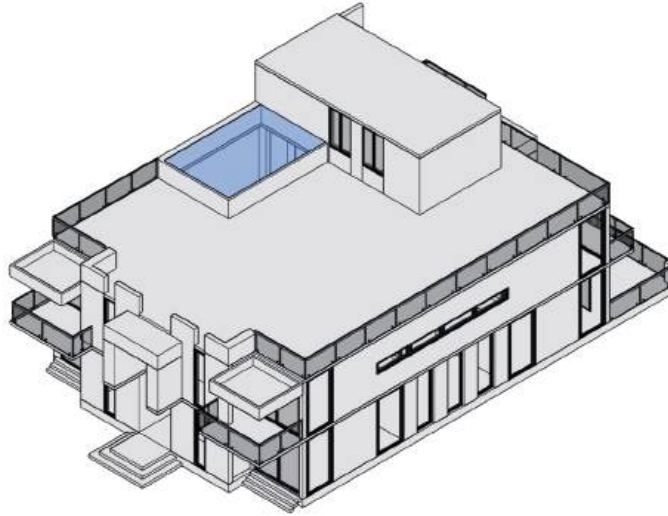

Since the beginning of human history, caves have carried a deep significance, both spiritually and culturally. They served as humanity's first homes, offering refuge from harsh climates and predators. Over time, caves became more than just places to live, they were sites of ritual and creativity.





Caves remind us that architecture didn't start with towering cities—it began with the simple act of finding shelter and then turning it into something meaningful ; a home.

This concept became the driving force behind 'The Urban Cave', a modern day interpretation of man's oldest dwelling.

Clad in Kota stone, the textured walls wrap the entire house, lending it a monolithic character with a grand, central entry anchoring the form





Its white and stone façade is complemented by a sleek boundary wall that protects the private realm within.



Located at a prominent T-junction in a neighbourhood in Panchkula, The Urban Cave stands with quiet elegance.

This house celebrates the fusion of classical symmetry and contemporary minimalism. It channels the essence of traditional architecture—symmetry, balance, and proportion—while embracing a minimalist, modern language.



## Spacious Living

Built on a 506 square metre plot, the residence features double height ceilings in all the four cardinals to expand the sense of space. The communal spaces are seamlessly connected, allowing for free movement and fostering an airy and expansive atmosphere.





At the centre of the house lies the living room, where the warmth of the wood meets the freshness of the greens, creating a perfect ambience for spending time with loved ones or entertaining guests.

Three bedrooms are positioned on the ground floor and two on the first, each carefully placed to align with Vastu principles while responding to the spatial logic of the overall design. Along the elevation facing the main road, narrow slit windows on the first floor provide privacy while allowing ample natural light to filter through. The layout ensures security without compromising openness.





The master bedroom on the ground floor is conceived as a duplex, with a private staircase connecting it to a dressing area and washroom on the first floor. This split-level arrangement creates a layered spatial experience, setting the master suite apart as a distinctly personal domain within the home.

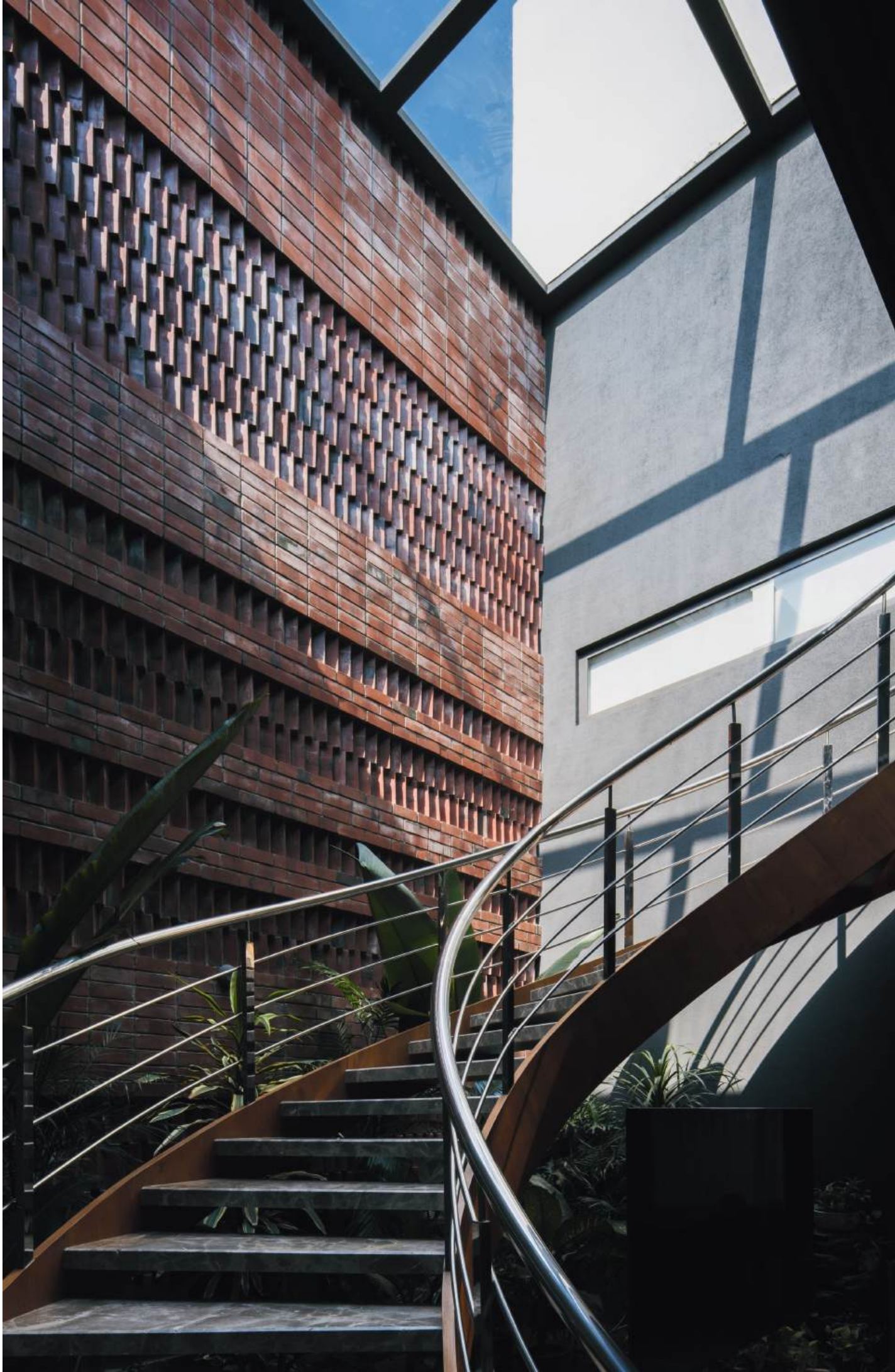




## Tendrils and Terracotta

An indoor garden thrives beneath it, nourished by the ever-shifting play of light pouring through the skylight above.

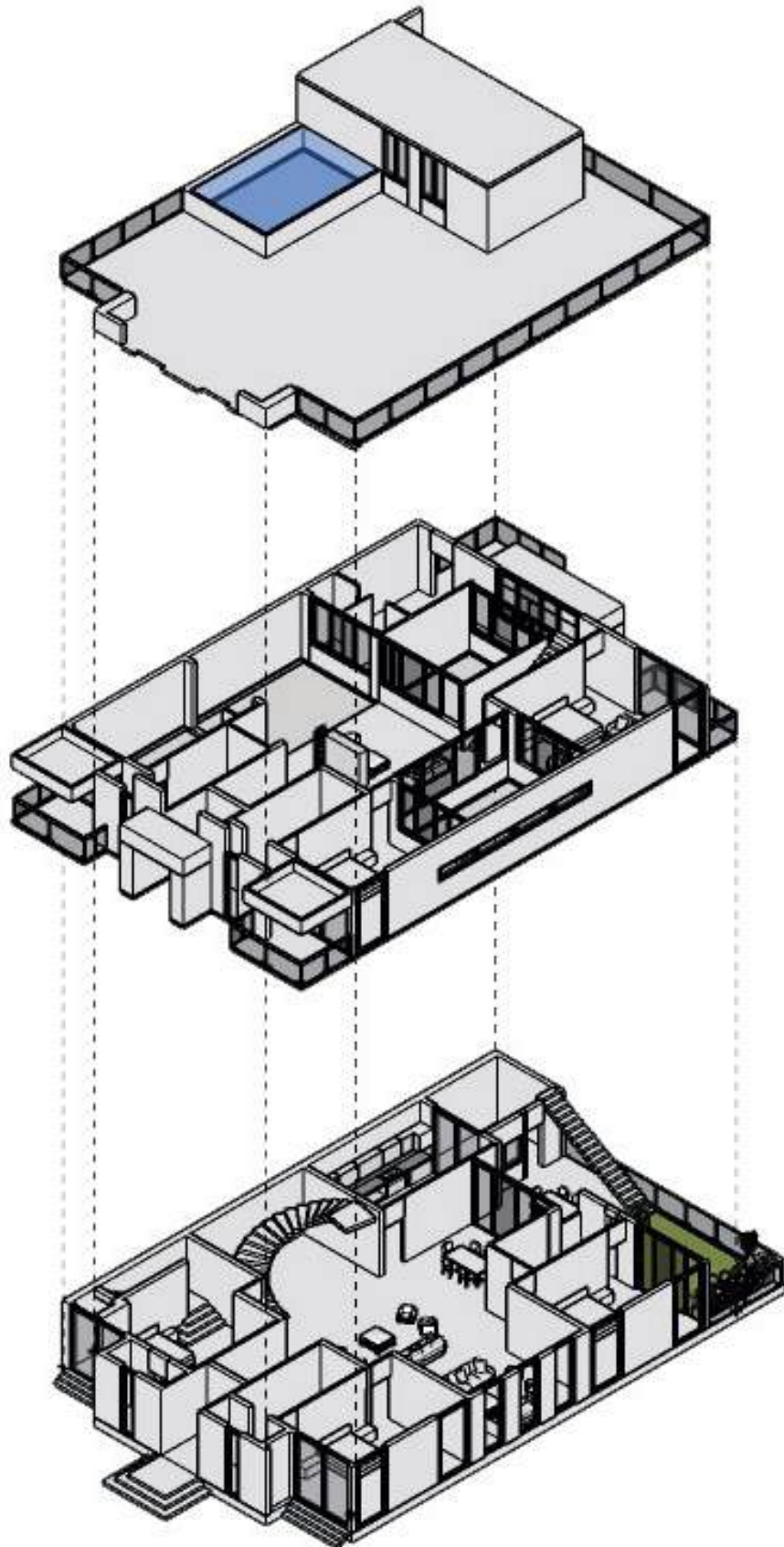




Behind the greens, the double-height brick wall with its rhythmic pattern adds an earthy, rustic charm to the house.

## A Shelter for Generations

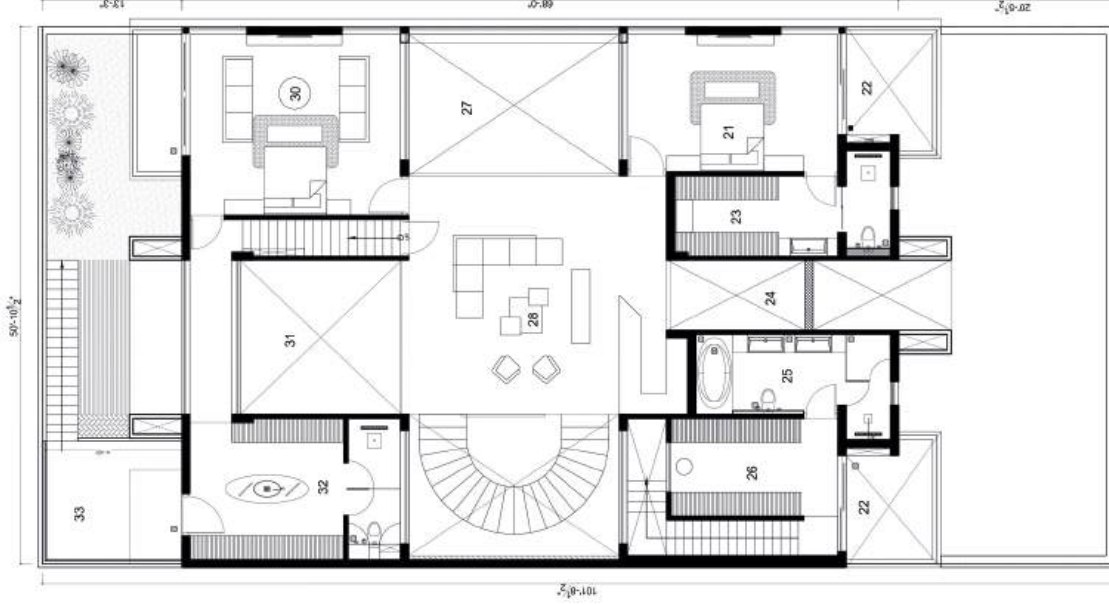
While its expression is contemporary, the home draws from an age-old understanding of what a shelter has always meant: comfort, enclosure and connection.





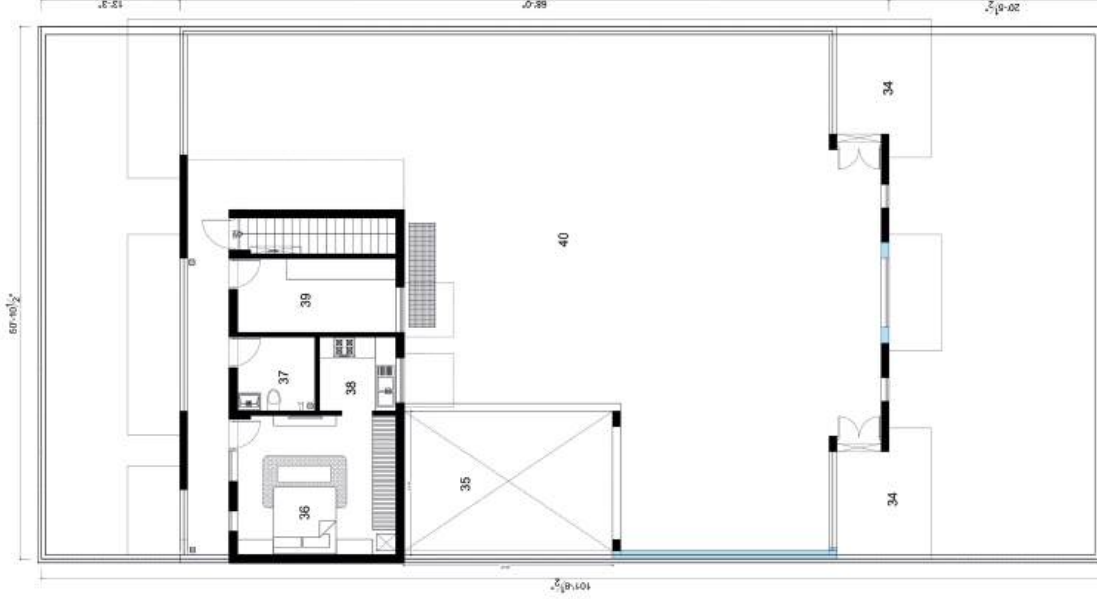
