

THE SKYBOX HOUSE

| SECTOR 29, PANCHKULA, INDIA



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At first glance, a cantilevered box, a pilot's dreams, and Himalayan foothills may seem unconnected, but together, they define the spirit of this home.

Designed for a family of three—a young pilot, his partner, and their child—this residence reflects their longing for light, balance, and belonging.

It is a space where the sky enters gently, and architecture becomes a quiet flight—suspended, serene, and grounded in meaning, much like the name it carries.





Elevated, Mindful Living

Amidst the structured rhythm of suburban life, Sky Box House creates a calm, light-filled haven where the family can reconnect, reflect, and rise above the ordinary. Modern yet meditative, it captures the spirit of openness and flight—an airy escape rooted in intention.





Built on a 240-square-meter plot in the Himalayan foothills, the design seeks to balance openness with shelter. Light-filled volumes, flowing spatial connections, and a central axis promote togetherness—offering airy, relaxing spaces while maintaining warmth, privacy, and familial harmony throughout.



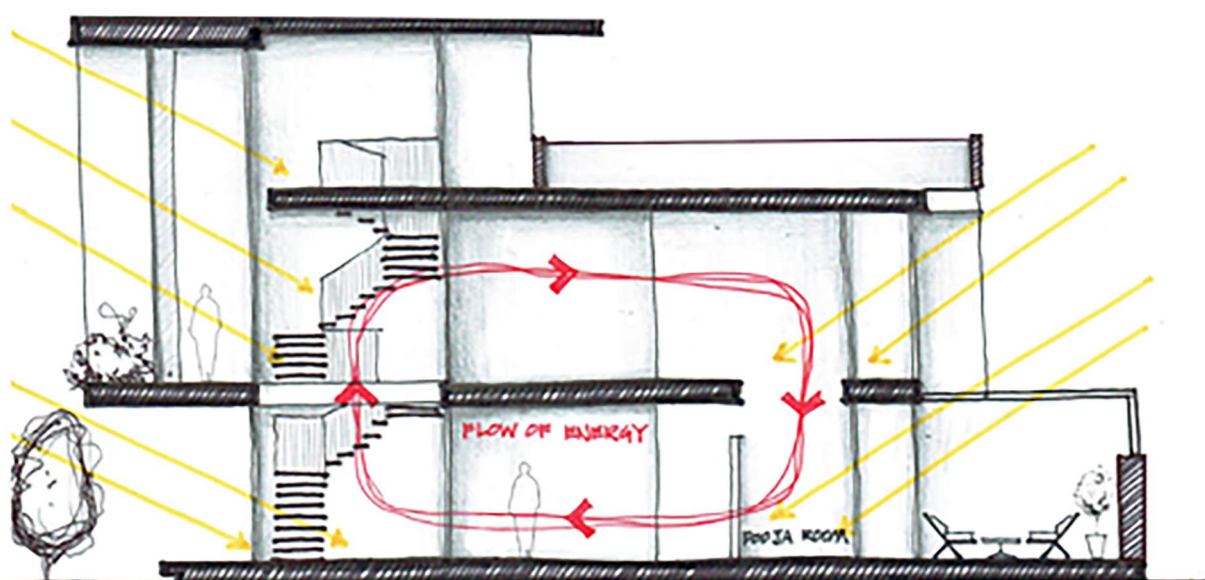
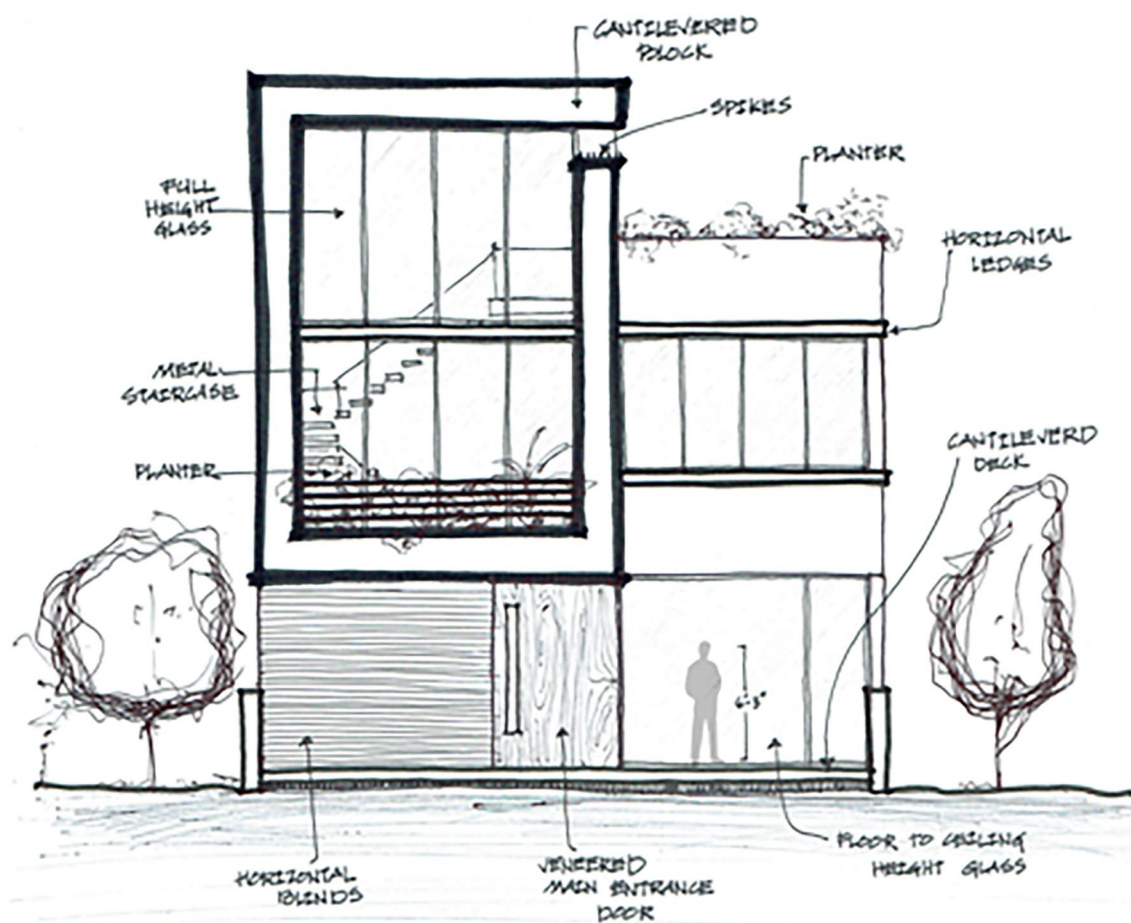


The lobby forms the heart of the Sky Box House, acting as both a visual and spatial anchor that links all major areas. Flanked by the sculptural staircase and the double-height void, it receives a soft wash of daylight filtering through full-height glass. The space transitions seamlessly between public and private zones, offering glimpses of the front









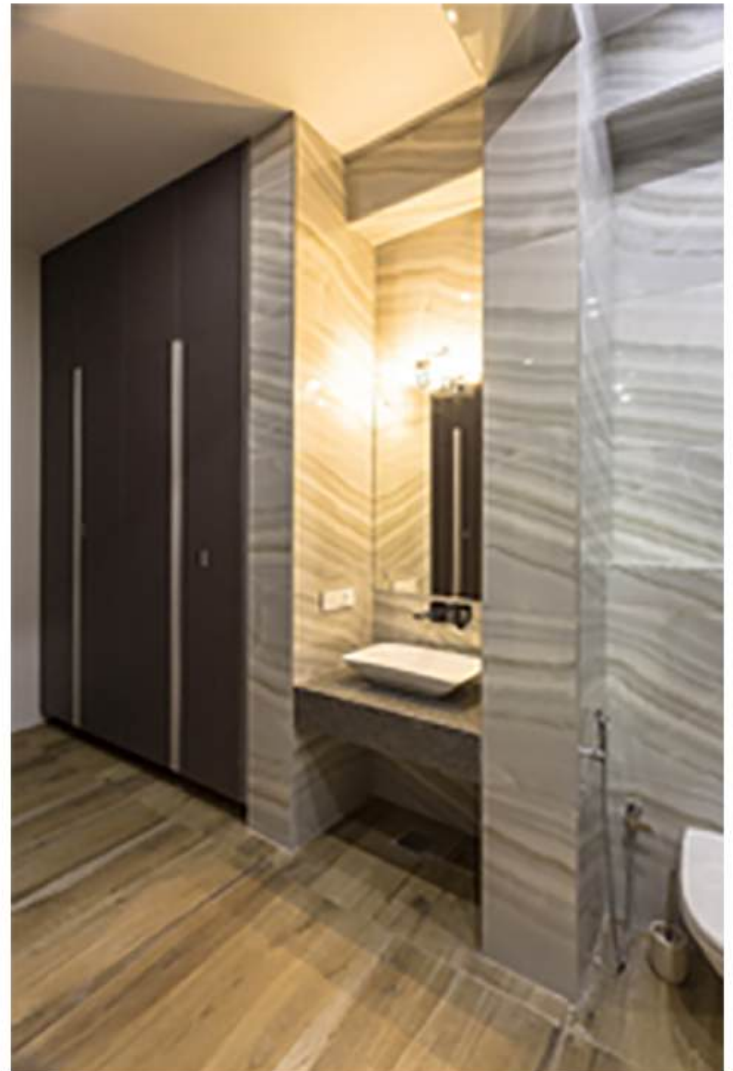
Restrained yet Radiant

Each washroom in the Sky Box House is designed as a serene, light-filled retreat—where the interplay of muted materials, diffused daylight, and precise detailing transforms everyday rituals into moments of calm and reflection.

The washrooms are treated as more than functional spaces—they are integral components of the home's overarching design ethos of light, simplicity and proportion.

Placed in the central zone of the house, the bathrooms are equipped with skylights so that natural daylight and ventilation permeate the spaces—this strategy allows the washrooms to enjoy a connection with the outdoors while still maintaining privacy.

The sanitary fittings are drawn from premium brands complementing the clean, restrained palette of the interiors. Dwell In essence, the washrooms here reflect the project's commitment to using light as a design material and to making even the often-overlooked spaces feel restful and elevated in experience.





Floating yet Grounded

Constructed on a small rectangular 240 sq. meters lot of land located in the Himalayan foothills, the Sky Box House is guided by three main design aspects – Light, Simplicity and Proportions.

The exploded view reveals a clear spatial strategy. A visual continuity of spaces is achieved along the central spine, uniting the Front garden, Entrance foyer, Hallway, Puja room and Rear deck. Each volume has been layered thoughtfully to allow for natural light, spatial fluidity and energy flow, as inspired by Vastu.

The house has been designed to defy time and budget constraints, using double-height spaces, cut-outs, and full-height glazing to bring in bundles of daylight—making the interiors feel airy, connected and comfortably grounded in their context.





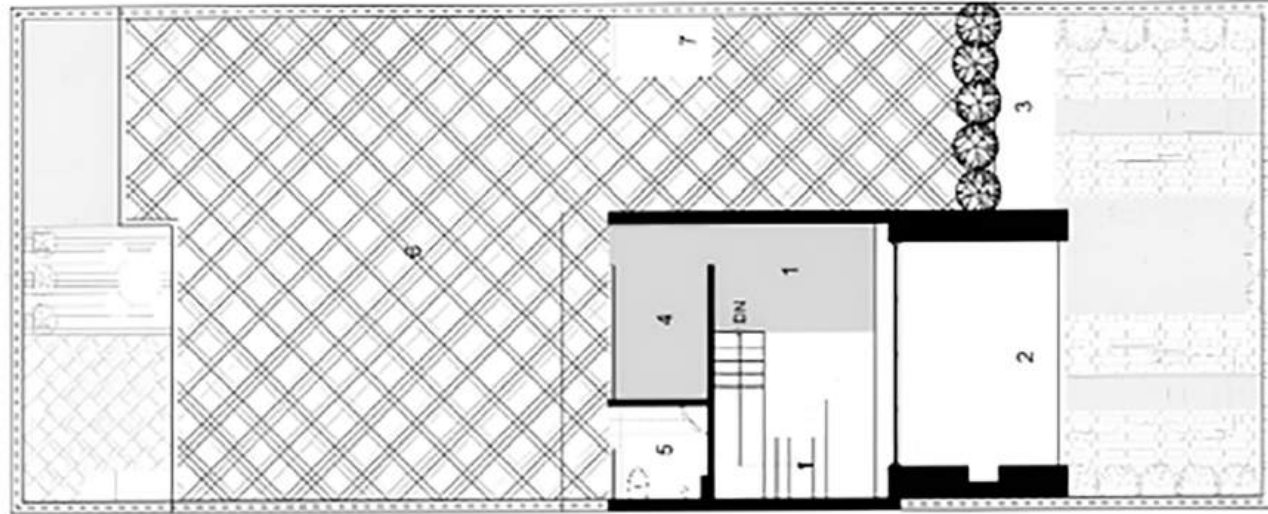
GROUND FLOOR PLAN
