

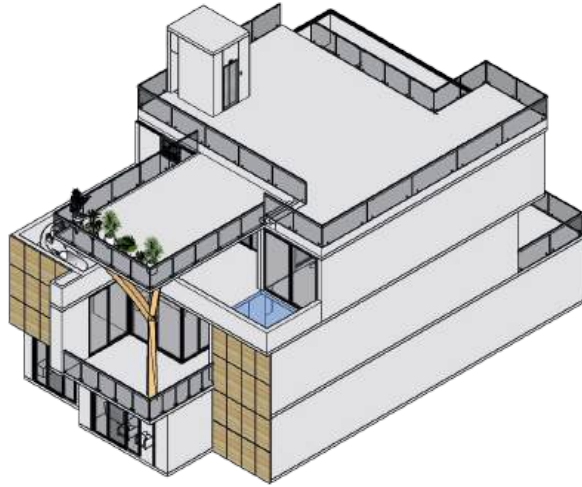

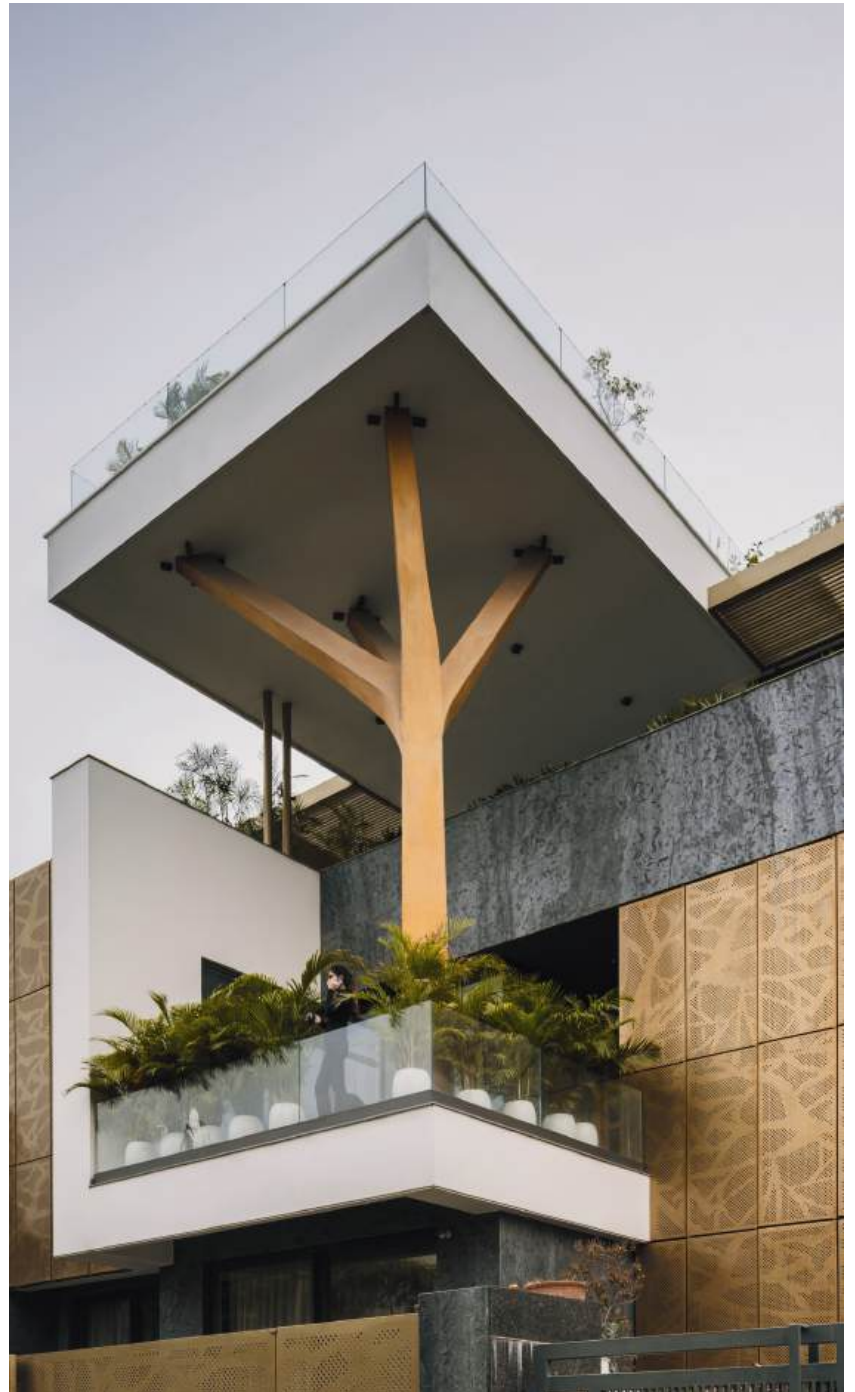


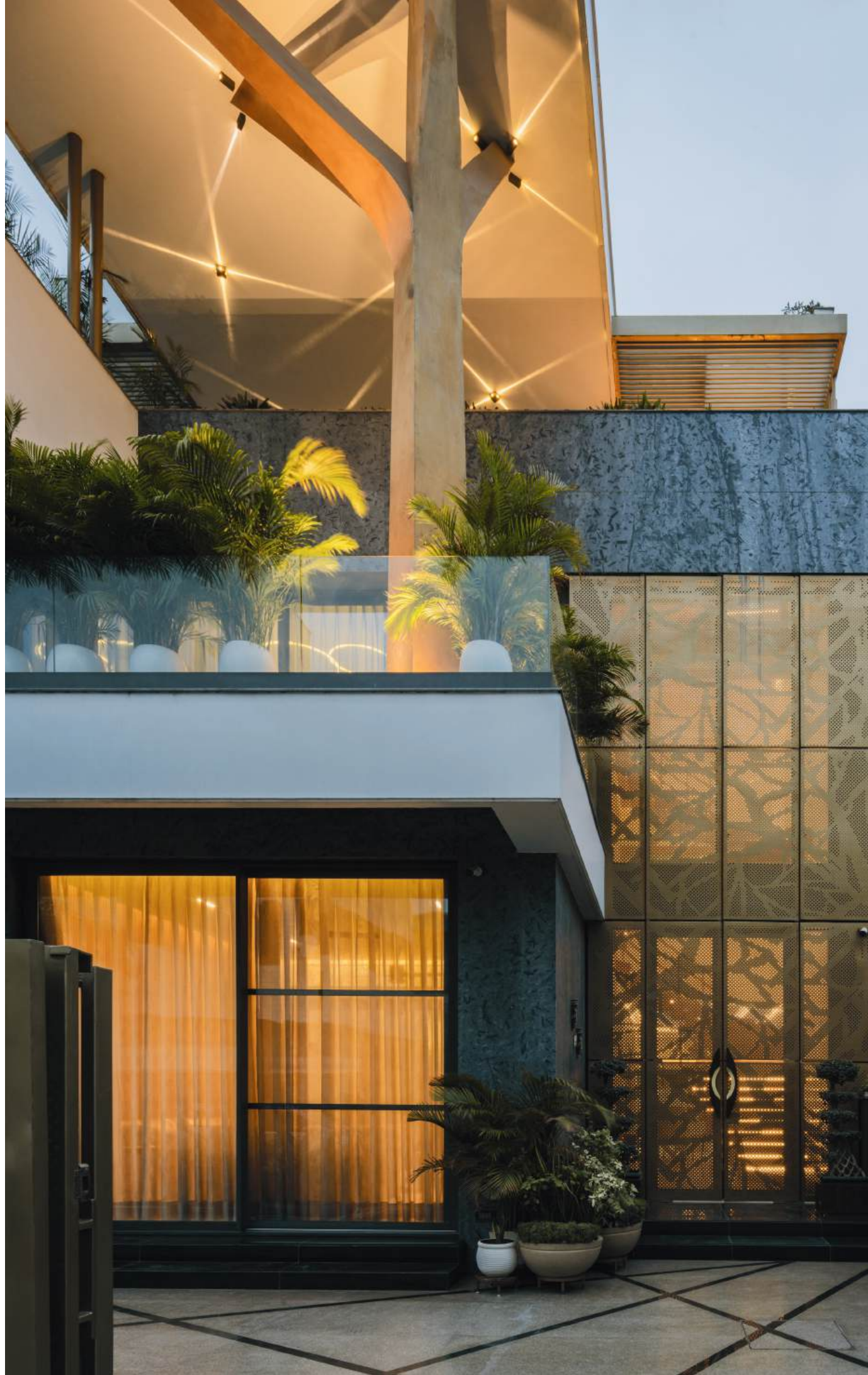
Tree as a Muse

The golden façade, with its intricate latticework, takes inspiration from the intertwining branches of a tree. Mirroring a forest canopy, sunlight filters through these patterns and fills the home with soft, natural light. Positioned to the south, this screen serves as an essential climate control feature, diffusing the region's harsh sunlight while facilitating airflow to cool and ventilate the interiors.

Every detail of this house, from the flooring to the lighting, celebrates arboreal beauty and charm. Just as a tree is synonymous with shade and shelter, this home is designed to provide comfort for generations to come.







The Jewel Staircase

Moving through the majestic doors, one is greeted by the splendour of a unique sculptural staircase. It is designed in the shape of the Indian rupee, complementing the client's profession as a builder. As dawn turns to dusk, the rupee-shaped staircase glows like a jewel, spiralling elegantly across the triple-height space.





The steps are bevelled in an artistic manner to resemble gemstones set in a necklace, reminiscent of the precious stones often discovered in caves.

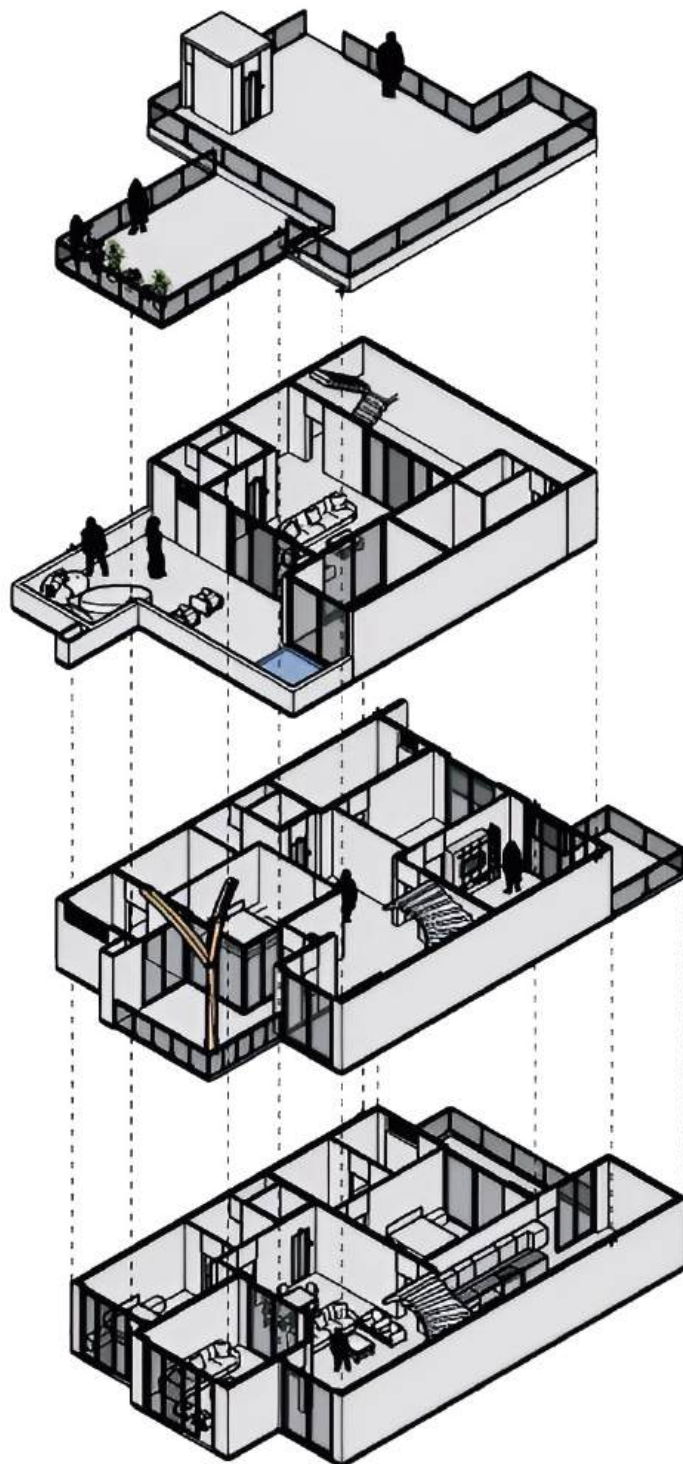


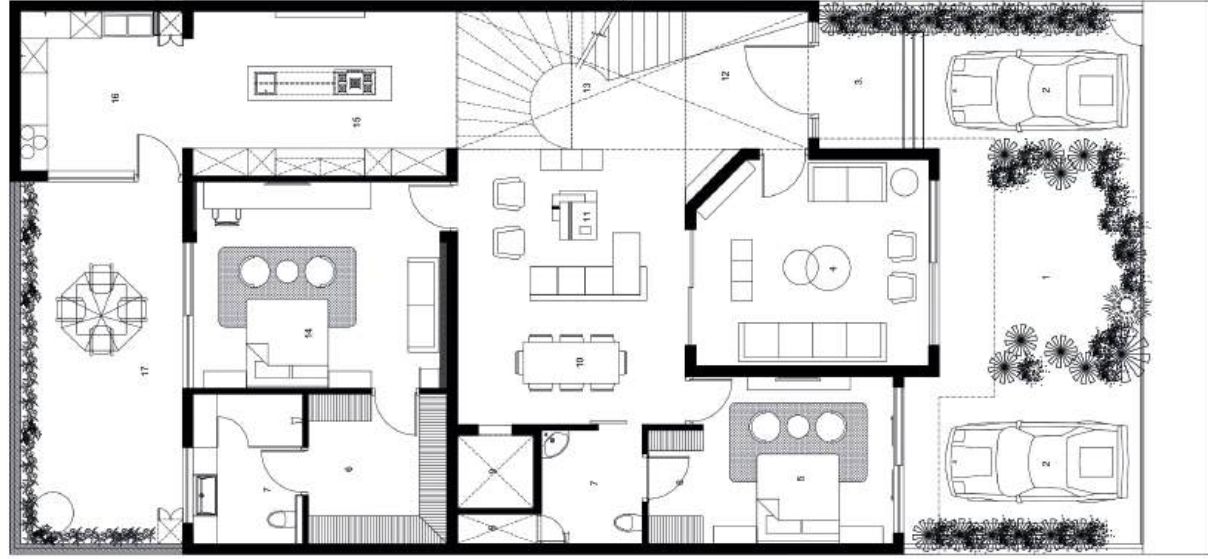


Delicate wooden railings add grace to the staircase, twirling like ribbons along its contours.

A Fusion of Past and Present

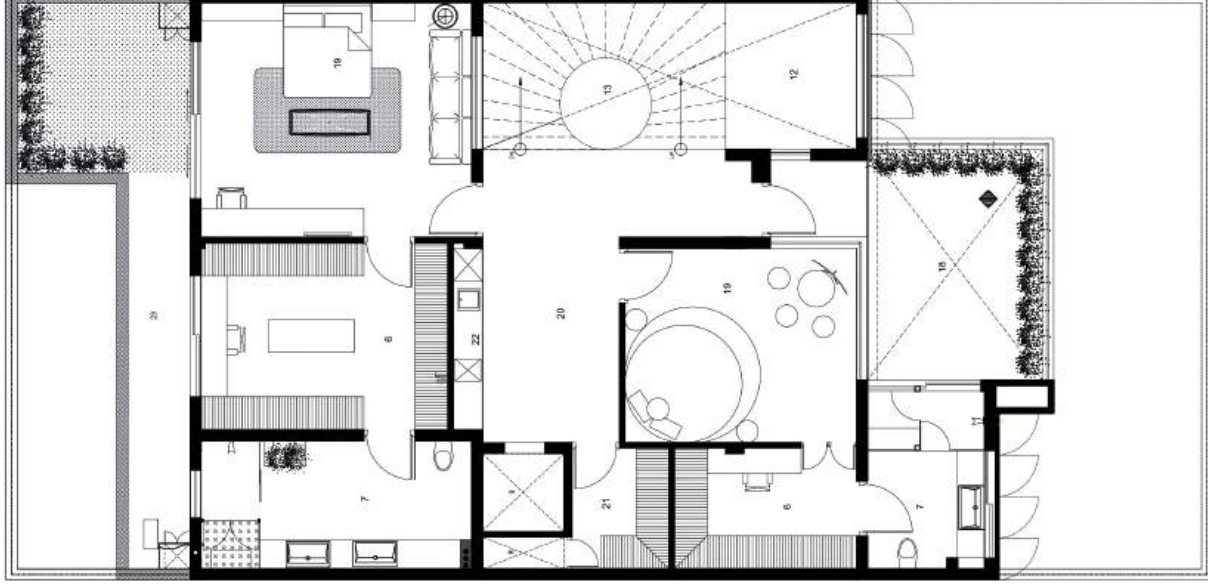

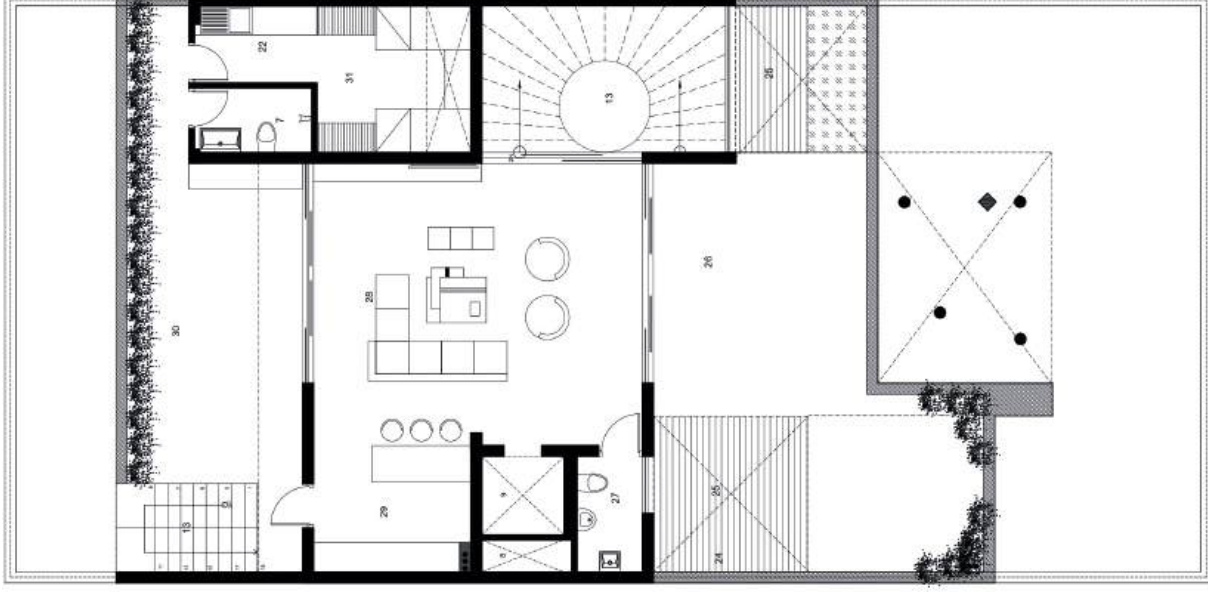
