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Set on a sunlit corner in Mohali, Lacuna House blends graceful design with a sense of openness and warmth. Created for grandparents and their two children's families, it offers inviting shared spaces for connection and calm, private areas for rest and quiet.





The name "Lacuna," meaning a gap or niche, beautifully shapes the home's design. Graceful recesses soften the structure, add depth to the façade, and let natural light flow into the interiors. These sculpted details give the house its unique charm, blending purpose with poetic expression

Defined by clarity and openness, the side façade of Lacuna House features sculpted grey niches that break the massing and bring depth to the structure.



At night, the side façade of Lacuna House glows softly. Lights highlight the grey niches, creating depth with shadows, while the warm indoor glow adds a calm and welcoming feel.

From a 45-degree view, Lacuna House reveals its thoughtful geometry and restraint. Positioned on a corner plot, the house takes full advantage of light and ventilation from both sides.

Durability and function guided every design decision. Materials were chosen for their long-lasting quality and ease of maintenance. Natural light and ventilation were maximized to reduce dependency on artificial systems

The interiors draw from Scandinavian minimalism—subtle, restrained, and calm. A neutral palette of creams and soft greens runs throughout the house, paired with natural wood and pockets of greenery.



The staircase is designed to blend into the material and visual language of the house. With its sleek profile and quiet presence, it supports movement across levels without calling attention to itself—another reflection of how Lacuna House balances bold structure with lived softness.



In a house defined by calm neutrals, the kitchen becomes a personal expression. Its deep blue tone, inspired by the family's dream car, brings identity to the space without overwhelming it.



From the very first step through the main door, all three axes of the house—horizontal, vertical, and longitudinal—are visible.

Gracefully designed for generations, this vastu-compliant home blends comfort, connection, and calm within a thoughtfully efficient layout. Light-filled and airy, it balances spacious living with intimate privacy, offering timeless elegance in every detail.

Every design choice was guided by durability and ease, with timeless materials and natural elements ensuring lasting beauty and comfort. A serene, light-filled atmosphere flows throughout, while a private basement studio allows work and home life to coexist with quiet harmony.





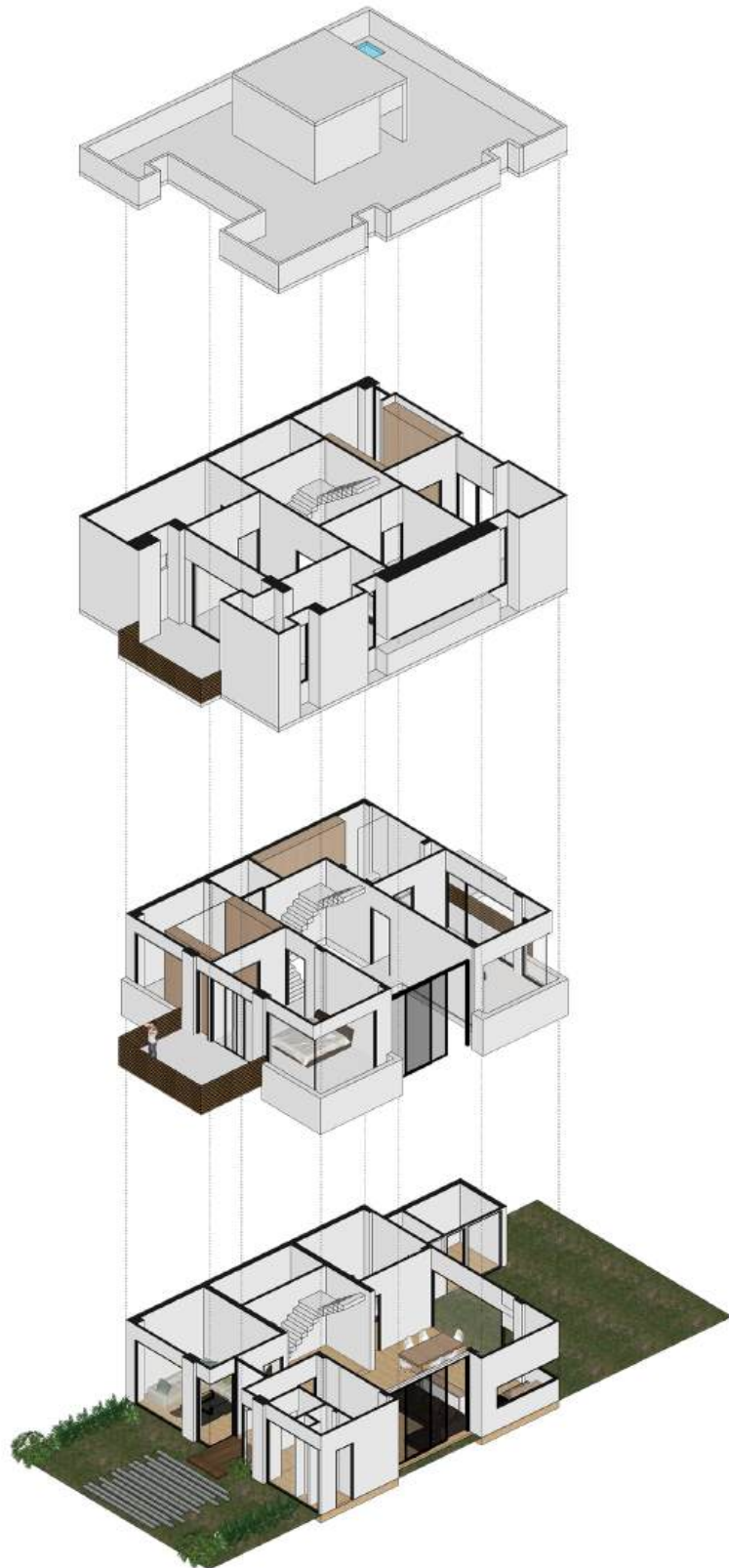
The house was planned to accommodate two families comfortably without feeling overcrowded. Rooms are arranged to allow fluid movement and interaction, while also offering zones for personal retreat.

Washrooms are designed with full-length mirrored wardrobes that visually expand the space, while bedrooms include cozy nooks filled with books and plants, bringing softness and intimacy into daily routines.



Where Corners Create Connection

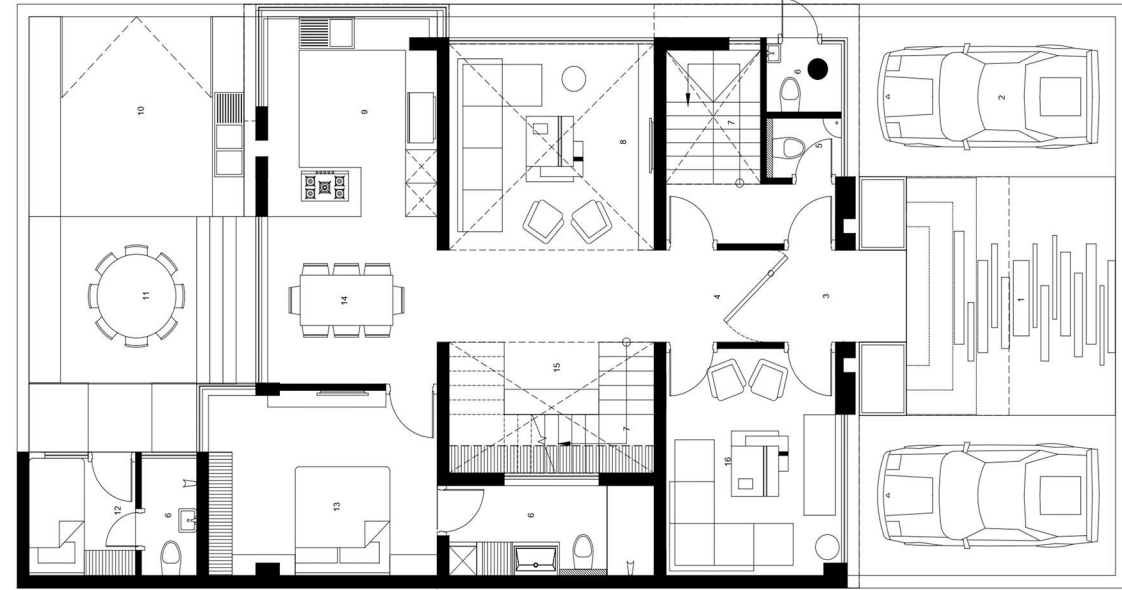

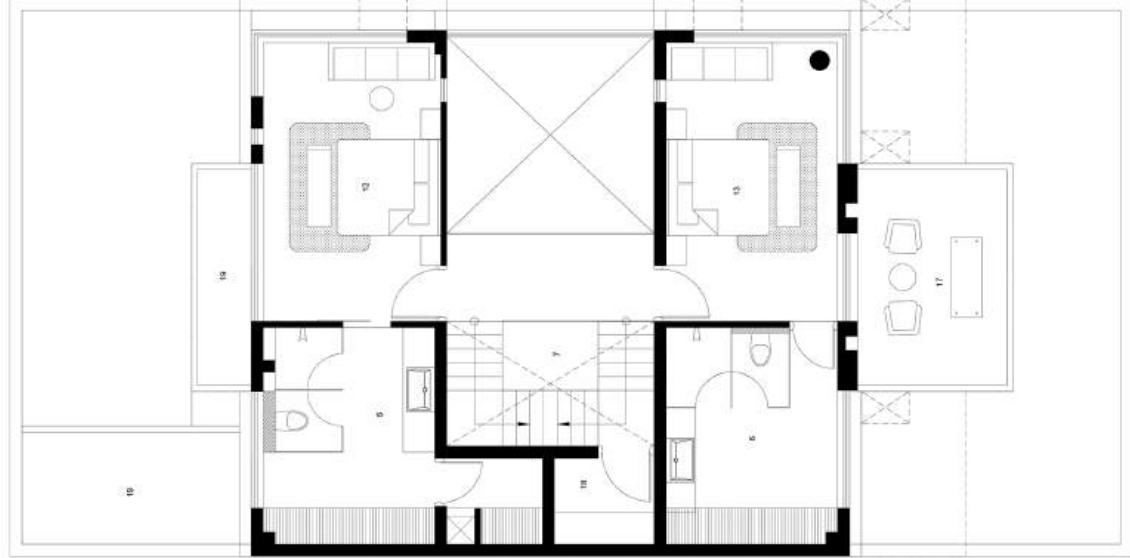

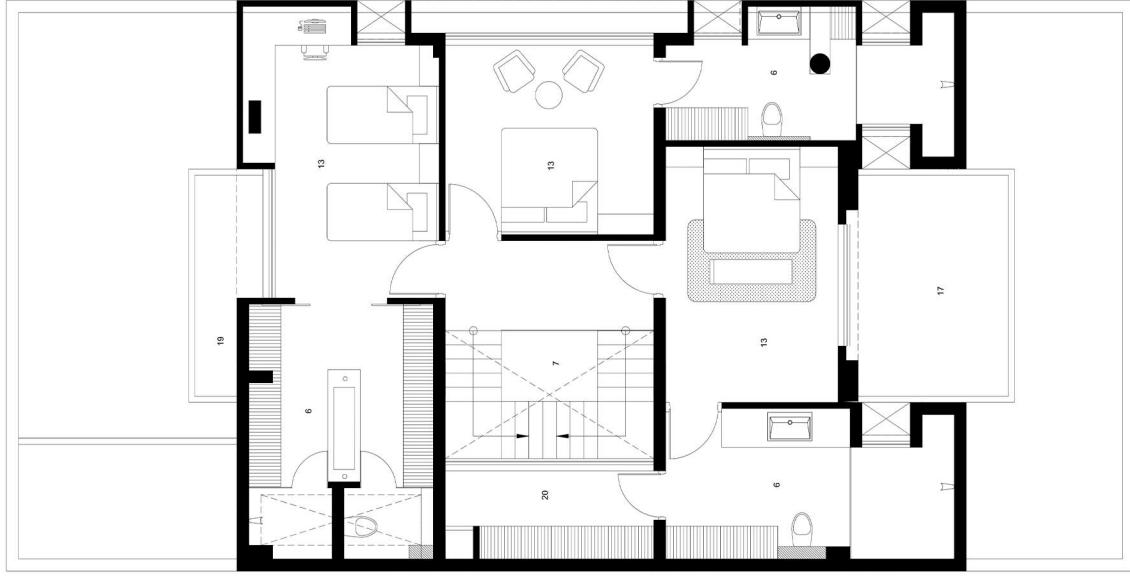
GROUND FLOOR PLAN
